

Tevredenheidsonderzoek onder ouders 2019/2020

The AICS is an international school and is accredited by the Council of International Schools (CIS). As part of the CIS accreditation, the AICS has recently conducted a survey on students' and parents' satisfaction.

Here we will present our findings.

Education

Most parents (88%) feel that their child is engaged in his/her learning and that their child's teachers have the necessary skills to teach the curriculum.

Although a significant amount of parents indicates that the unique abilities and needs of their child were not identified prior to entry into school (38%), most parents (73%) do feel that their child's learning needs are adequately supported by the school.

A lot of parents also feel that the curriculum meets their child's needs and that their child is appropriately challenged (76%).

Communication

Parents feel that the school could improve its parental communications and include parents more in decisions about their child's education. However, a lot of parents (74%) feel that the school does provide sufficient information reflecting the achievement and progress of their child.

(Social) safety

Parents trust that their child is safe at school and on school trips. They also feel that the school provides a healthy and safe environment for their child and a secure environment for all members of the school community.

ICT

Parents are positive about the use of ICT in school; they (88% of parents) feel that the school uses information technology to enhance learning. Some parents (18%) indicate that the school could improve its effort to help children use IT and social media in a responsible way.
