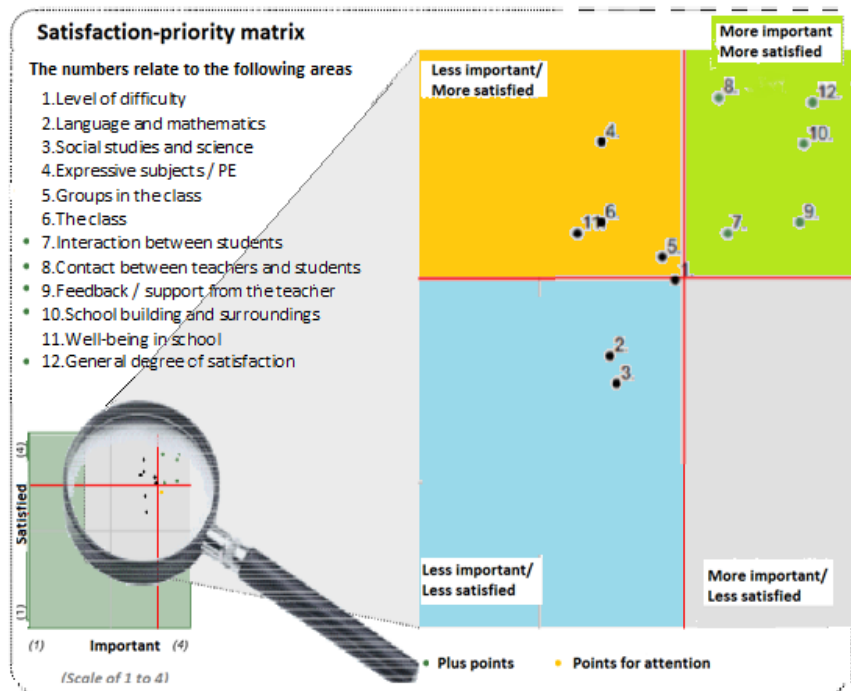
Results of the Students' Satisfaction Survey

The survey was given to all the students from group 5, 6, 7, and 8. Throughout the whole of the Netherlands, some 193 577 students have taken part in 2 120 comparable surveys in other Dutch primary schools. The group 5 to 8 students from these schools form the 'reference' for comparing the results. 252 questionnaires were completed by students from IPS Hilversum. 119 students from groups 5 & 6 and 133 students from groups 7 & 8.

Students, in general, are very satisfied with the school

The survey provides a clear indication of how satisfied students are with the school. The average score for all schools in the 'reference group' is 8.1 and for **IPS Hilversum is 8.6**. The appreciation of the school by the students is scored as 'very good'.

Points 2 & 3 are scored low by the children as they refer to questions on how hard they find their studies. Our students welcome and enjoy challenges, and this is not an issue we need to address, but more a reflection of the type of questioning.



According to the students' survey, the school can use five significantly positive aspects in its profile:

- The interaction between the students
- The teacher contact between teachers and students
- The feedback and support from the teacher
- The general degree of satisfaction
- The school building and its surroundings

The surveys will be conducted again in the autumn of 2020. At that point the results will be summarized and placed in PO Vensters.
